WHAT IS SAFETY ONTOUR?

Safety On Tour is a mobile safety demonstration program operated by the BC Construction Safety Alliance (BCCSA).

The 17' trailer travels across BC to deliver **interactive, high-impact safety demos** to construction sites, schools, trade shows, and community events - promoting safety as a shared responsibility province-wide.

WHAT DEMONSTRATIONS ARE OFFERED?

- **Fall Arrest:** Simulates force and injury impact of a fall using a mannequin and lanyards.
- **Head Protection:** Shows benefits of helmet protection using a 3-lb hammer.
- **Eye Protection:** Demonstrates benefits of safety vs. non-safety glasses with an air nailer.
- **Hand Safety:** Compares cut-resistant vs. basic gloves.
- **Safe Lifting:** Uses a robot to show how to reduce injury risk with correct lifting posture.

HOW DOES IT ENGAGE AUDIENCES?

Each session features **short, hands-on demos** that make safety real through live simulations, volunteer participation, and relatable stories. Presenters mix **visuals, true cases and humour** to leave lasting impressions for workers, students, and DIYers alike.
